Some things to do: Make sure to drive to the top of Mt Gabriel where the two 'golfball' radars are (this is part of the North Atlantic air traffic control network keeping people safe in the air). On the road to Schull about 2km after the right turn (signpost) to Schull at the foot of the road look for an unmarked turn on the right — it follows immediately from a turn marked 'Cul de sac' - AFTER the Cul de Sac sign turn right and take STEEP drive up the mountain to the top. On a good day the view is FABULOUS. Drive the GOAT'S PATH on the Sheep's Head, great views, more tiny roads. Drive the HEALY PASS for ultimate tiny roads up-a-mountain full of sheep experience. Take the ferry from Glengarriff to GARNISH ISLAND- great gardens and views. BANTRY market FRIDAYS. Nearest petrol station is Ballydehob. Also go to MIZEN HEAD and the BARLEY COVE- fantastic views (again). We loved it here- hope you will too.
